- Applicant must be a student in good standing and a transcript must be provided with the application (cumulative GPA 3.0 or above is recommended).

All applications are due by June 3, 2022. The CSSGA Board of Directors will then select the scholarship finalist in June. The scholarship finalist will then be asked to attend a subsequent Board Meeting to formally receive recognition of the scholarship.
